Chelsea Gonzalez (Writer/Director) was named 'Most Power Voice' by New York's Blackbird Film Festival for her first short film, SUSANNE AND THE MAN. The film was an official selection at 25 film festivals including Sarasota, DeadCenter, and DC Independent. She went on to take top honors at the Los Angeles Connect Film Festival (Best Comedic Short) and San Francisco

Actors Film Festival (Best Actor). As an actress, Chelsea appears on THE MINDY PROJECT, CRIMINAL MINDS, CASTLE, THE JINX, and OUIJA: ORIGIN OF EVIL. She acted across Kathy Bates in the upcoming drama HOME currently in post-production. ALL THE WRONG THINGS is Chelsea's directorial debut and her love for this new side of the industry has led her to seriously pursue future directing opportunities.
